## Additional Instructions & Notes

A spur of the horse trail crosses through the retention island that separates the north & south burn units of stand 61. That island protects a homestead site, so equipment must stay on the road through it. The first version of this FTP was approved in early 2024. This revised version adds stand 19 to the Walsh Road Barrens burn area, as prescribed through the 2026 YOE planning process.
