

Ordinance Number 17

An ordinance for the trimming of trees over public walks in Freeport MI.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF FREEPORT

that property owners be required to cut off all limbs or branches of trees overhanging the public walkways of this Village, within a height of seven feet 6 inches off the ground where such obstruction occurs abutting their property.

If this ordinance is not complied with within a space of 30 days from publication of this ordinance, this is to be done by the Village at the expense of several property owners.

A motion made by C.A Bigbee and seconded by Charles Hooper that this ordinance be accepted, adopted and published. Ayes all. Absent 2.
