### ***Fish Species***

Brown Trout

### ***Species Description***

Brown trout average 8-12 inches, but fish larger than 20 inches are commonly reported by anglers. Brown trout up to 23 inches have been collected during DNR Fisheries surveys.

### ***Geographic Coordinates***

### ***Noteworthy***

This stream has been dredged and channelized. The current is swift and many spots are too deep to wade. Most anglers fish this river out of a canoe or rowboat.

### ***Fishing Regulations***

Dowagiac River at Sink Road is a designated Type 4 trout stream. Brown trout are stocked in this stream reach annually. There may be some immigration of wild fish from tributary streams.

### ***Directions to Site***

The access site off Sink Road is approximately 300 ft northwest of the Edwards Street intersection. Grassed parking area along road and carry-in access for canoes or small boats. It is only about 30 ft from the staging area to the river.
