Noteworthy

Just upstream of the bridge is a sand trap maintained by the Department of Natural Resources. Use caution when wading.

Fishing Regulations

This site on the Sturgeon River at Sturgeon Valley Road is designated a Type 1 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide. The Sturgeon River is not stocked with trout, and is dependent upon natural reproduction.

Directions to Site

From Old Hwy 27 in Vanderbilt, take Sturgeon Valley Road east for 11 miles to the stream crossing. There is a roadside pullout large enough for 2-3 cars.
