Brook Trout

Species Description

Fall fingerling brook trout are stocked annually. Fisheries surveys have found good survival and growth of these stocked fish. Brook trout typically range in size from 5 to 13 inches.

Noteworthy

This lake is created by a large beaver dam holding back groundwater coming out of the hillsides. There is a primary channel that flows through the center of the lake so anglers should target that along with any open pockets in the scattered vegetation. The access site limits anglers to small hand-carry watercraft such as a kayak, canoe or float tube. This lake is nicely situated along a hillside which can offer some great wildlife viewing opportunities.

Fishing Regulations

Noamikong Lake is a designated Type A trout lake. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Lake Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

This location is North of Eckerman Corners (M-28 and M-123). Drive North on M-123 for about 11 miles to Lakeshore Drive (Curley Lewis Highway) and turn right (East). Follow Lakeshore Drive for about two miles to East West road (gravel road) and turn right. In about 3.8 miles turn right onto a tight two-track. There is a parking area for lake access that will accommodate one to two vehicles.
