Brook Trout; Rainbow Trout; Steelhead

Species Description

A Fisheries Survey conducted in 2013 reported catches of brook trout, Chinook salmon, rainbow trout and coho salmon.

Noteworthy

The Black River supports a salmon spawning run and contains resident populations of both brook and rainbow trout.

Fishing Regulations

The area of the Black River at the Peter's Creek Truck Trail Footbridge has split regulations. Upstream from the Peter's Creek Truck Trail Footbridge the Black River is designated as a Type 1 trout stream. Downstream of the Peter's Truck Trail Footbridge it is designated as a Type 4 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From Naubinway, travel approximately 5.5 miles east on US-2. Turn left onto Black River Road (heading north) and travel approximately 2.1 miles, then turn left (west) onto Peter's Creek Road (Black River State Forest Campground). The Black River can be accessed by way of the Black River State Forest Campground.
