Species Description

Wild brook and brown trout are both present here. Brook trout up to 9 inches are common and brown trout can grow to 20 inches or larger in this reach.

Noteworthy

Cobble, gravel and sand holes are all present here. There is a fair amount of wood in the stream. It is generally easy for wading but there are some deep holes.

Fishing Regulations

The South Branch Au Sable River at Smith Bridge is a designated Gear Restricted stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing guide.

Directions to Site

From the M-72 bridge crossing of the South Branch Au Sable River, take M-72 west about a quarter mile and follow the signs on the north side of the road back to the parking lot at Smith Bridge. This site is about 13 miles east of I-75 off of M-72.
