

## Au Sable River - MDOT DNR Access

### ***Fish Species***

Brown Trout; Rainbow Trout

### ***Species Description***

Some wild brown trout are present at this location, and both rainbow trout and brown trout are also stocked. This is an annual spring stocking location. Brown trout typically range from 7-18 inches, but some fish can approach 25 inches. Rainbow trout, typically age 1 fish, range from 7-10 inches, with occasional fish up to 16 inches caught.

### ***Noteworthy***

Large access available for parking and launching canoes or drift boats, which many do from this location. Wading water is limited, but available with caution. Good presentations to use are dry flies, nymphs, spinners and crankbaits.

### ***Fishing Regulations***

### ***Directions to Site***

In the town of Mio, take M72/33 Highway south and turn right into the access site which is located before the bridge/river.
