Fish Species

Brown Trout; Rainbow Trout

Species Description

Some wild brown trout are present here and both rainbow trout and brown trout are also stocked. Brown trout typically range from 7-18 inches, but some fish can approach 25 inches. Rainbow trout, typically age 1 fish, range from 7-10 inches, with occasional fish up to 16 inches caught.

Noteworthy

Wading water is limited, but available with caution. Stairs down to water. Good presentations to use are dry flies, nymphs, spinners, and crankbaits. Multiple locations to enter the river along this loop road. Sand, cobble, gravel bottom. River is approximately 150 feet wide. U.S. Forest Service property, federal laws apply.
