

Carp River At East Lake Road



Fish Species

Brook Trout; Brown Trout; Steelhead

Species Description

The Carp River is stocked with both brown trout and steelhead, but natural reproduction of both species occurs. Brown trout, brook trout and steelhead can all be caught in this reach of the Carp, but densities are fairly low. In the fall, you might also catch some Chinook, coho or pink salmon.

Noteworthy

There's a parking area for 2-3 cars about 50 yards from the bridge. There is a trail to the river from the parking area. This river is approximately 20 feet wide. It can be waded, but watch for deep holes.

From the village of Moran, take M-123 to Charles Moran Road, then turn east. Then turn north on East Lake Road for 4.7 miles to the river crossing.
