Directions to Site

Turn Left (West) off Forest Hwy 13 approximately 24 miles North of Nahma Junction. Proceed on road past the Wide Waters Campground and continue on two-track for approximately 1.5 miles off Forest Hwy 13. Kay's Pond is located East through the woods and over the hill. Total walking distance is about 600 feet.
