Trueman Lake is a 6 acre lake located within the Hiawatha National Forest. Hike Lake has been managed for Brook Trout for more than 60 years. Trueman Lake is a Type A Trout Lake which provides anglers trout fishing opportunities from the last Saturday in April to September 30th.

## ***Directions to Site***

Turn North off of US-2 onto Forest Hwy 13. Travel 28.2 miles and turn Left (West) onto Buckhorn Rd (H 44). Travel 3.5 miles and then turn Right onto USFS 2266 Rd (Co Rd 639). Travel 1.3 miles and then turn Right (East) on to a two-track (USFS 2363 Rd). Proceed on USFS Rd 2363 for approximately 0.3 miles to Trueman Lake.
