

## Historical Marker - L219 - Saginaw Club (Marker ID#:L219)



### Front - Title/Description

#### **Saginaw Club**

Organized April 18, 1889, the club's membership was comprised of most of the leading business and civic figures of Saginaw. One of the first items of business was preparation for a clubhouse. Architect W. T. Cooper furnished plans, and ground was broken on July 1, 1889. Described as a monument to "enterprise, sagacity, and liberality," the clubhouse was opened on May 29, 1890. The inaugural event was a full-dress ball attended by eight hundred guests. Only slightly modified from its original design, the Saginaw Club has graced the main street of town for over eighty years.
