







Top Menu Signing in to FishCat to Unlock Patron Privileges


Once you sign in to FishCat, you will be able to sign out here. Being signed in allows you to request library materials be sent to you (available soon) and save bibliographic lists for future use.


Clicking the Reset button will return the screen to the home page and cause FishCat to sign you out of your account.

Clicking the Home Button will return the screen to the home page and keep you signed in to FishCat.





ANALYSIS OF FISHING AND THE GAME FISH CATCH IN BUDD LAKE. SUMMER OF 1935

Budd Lake is a long, narrow lake located in the village limits of Harrison on U. S. 27. A survey of this lake by Limar Braman shows that the lake has an area of 150 acres, and a maximum depth of slightly over 30 feet. A chemical and biological survey of this lake has not yet been made but it is anticipated that such a survey will be completed during the coming summer.

The census on Budd Lake was taken by a crew of men from Houghton Camp and was






Clicking any of the Bulletin Board buttons will open the website in a new browser window.
