



2024 Michigan elk hunt period 1

This map is valid for 2024 elk hunt period 1, for elk management unit X, during open season dates of Aug. 27-30, Sept. 13-16 and Sept. 27-30.

There are two hunt periods with different units and date ranges. Ensure this map is the correct map you need for your appropriate hunt period, unit, and date combination.

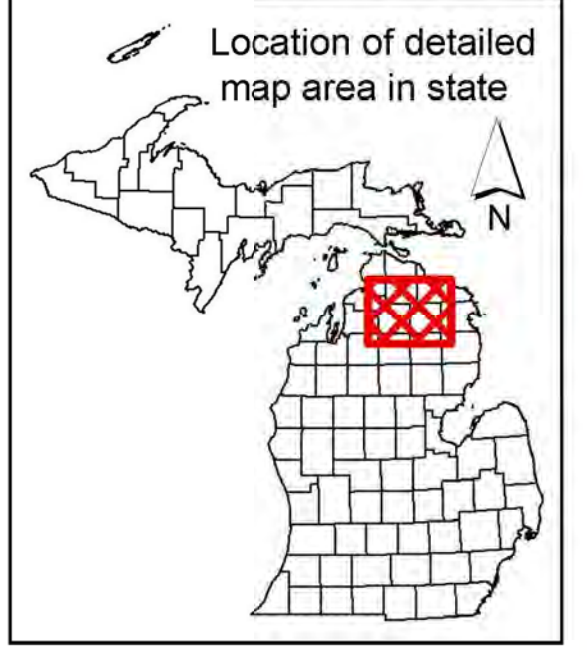
Elk check stations:

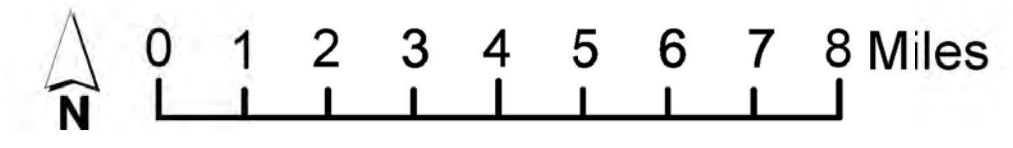
