


## North Central State Trail

### North Central State Trail

Part of Michigan's Iron Belle Trail

A 75-mile multi-use trail connecting Gaylord, Indian River, Cheboygan and Mackinaw City. The trail has a 57' wide paved, crushed limestone surface and is open to all non-motorized users year-round.

Open to snowmobiles  
December 1st to March 31st

### Notes:

The trail actually dips 772' between Gaylord and Indian River.

Site markers use the National Michigan Central Railroad numbering from Bay City to Mackinaw. Mile Marker 25 is just north of Gaylord and Mile Marker 10 is south of Mackinaw City.

Cell phone signal coverage along the trail is limited.
