### Cost

### Reservations

Reservations for 3 hours max can be made by contacting the park office during business hours (Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.) Additional hours by request during hunting season.

### Park entry

The Track Chair will be brought to the parking lot location of your choice inside Island Lake Recreation Area. Track chairs are not allowed on the Blue and Yellow Multi-use trails.

A Recreation Passport is required on all vehicles entering the park. Recreation Passports may be purchased at the Michigan Secretary of State offices or at park entrances.

### Optional Equipment

Fishing rod and firearm holders, head light, and attendant control.

### Safety and rules

Service animals are welcome but must be under the control of their handler or a companion at all times. Visitors with pets must adhere to the state park rules regarding pets. Be advised that leashes, long clothing, blankets or other dangling items (i.e. camera straps, etc.) are at risk of becoming entangled in the chair. All track chair users must sign a waiver of liability. Ask for brochure with more detailed safety information.

### Transfer options

If assistance is needed to transfer to the track chair, a companion must be able to assist with the transfer. Park staff and/or volunteers are unable to assist with transfers.

### What to bring

You may want to bring water, bug spray, weather-appropriate clothing, a seat cushion, a hat, sunblock, sunglasses, snacks or a camera.
