Track chair opportunities!

Waterloo Recreation Area's track chair program helps provide accessibility to the park's nature trails, wildlife and scenery.

Cost

Use of the track chair is free of charge, and is available on a first-come, first-reserved basis. Track chairs were generously donated by Kali's Cure for Paralysis Foundation.

Reservations

The track chair may be reserved in hour increments by contacting the park office during business hours (Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.)

Park entry

The Track Chair is located at the Discovery Center to access the nature trails, scenery, birds, and wildlife but can also be used throughout the Waterloo Recreation Area and neighboring DNR lands per request for hunting and fishing.

A Recreation Passport is required on all vehicles entering the park. Recreation Passports may be purchased at the Michigan Secretary of State offices or at park entrances.

Optional Equipment

There is optional equipment available that you can request when making a reservation. These options are a utility tray, fishing rod holder, gun rack (also holds a cane well), and a uni-mount rifle rest.

Safety and rules

Service animals are welcome but must be under the control of their handler or a companion at all times. Visitors with pets must adhere to the state park rules regarding pets. Be advised that leashes, long clothing, blankets or other dangling items (i.e. camera straps, etc.) are at risk of becoming entangled in the chair. All track chair users must sign a waiver of liability. Ask for brochure with more detailed safety information.

Transfer options

If assistance is needed to transfer to the track chair, a companion must be able to assist with the transfer. Park staff and/or volunteers are unable to assist with transfers.

What to bring

You may want to bring water, bug spray, weather-appropriate clothing, a seat cushion, a hat, sunblock, sunglasses, snacks or a camera.
