Species Description

Brook trout are the primary trout species encountered at this location.

Noteworthy

This is the old sand trap which is still cleansed of unwanted materials on occasion. The trap is near the Tin Shanty Bridge and is a slow deep basin with an associated upland pad. This site is a popular location for local campers. It is close to the road, but far enough away not to hear it. Brook trout of all sizes can be captured in this reach, but pressure is slightly higher.

Fishing Regulations

This site on the Main Branch of the Black River is designated as Gear Restricted. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the Tin Shanty Bridge access site, head north to first two-track trail road on right (east) approximately 0.1 mile. Turn east, bear to the right and follow road to end at access area.
