Rainbow Trout/Steelhead

Species Description

Rainbow trout/steelhead can be caught in the Rabbit River during late fall, winter, and spring. Brown trout are rarely caught below Hamilton Dam, but can be caught in areas near the city of Wayland.

Access site is below Hamilton Dam off of M-40 and Willyard Street. Parking is available for 20 vehicles but there is no boat launch/skid pier. Shore fishing, wading, and small watercraft opportunities are provided at this site.
