Fish Species

Brook Trout; Brown Trout; Steelhead

Species Description

Yearling Brown Trout are stocked annually to supplement natural reproduction. Brown Trout greater than 20 inches are caught here with most in the 10-15 inch range. The Brook Trout population is wild here and offers fish ranging from 7-10 inches. Spring spawning steelhead offer another opportunity for anglers.

Noteworthy

The Au Train River between the Basin and Lake is only wadeable. Some deep holes exist with holding structure for those big Brownies. There is abundant large woody structure throughout the entire stretch and can be a challenge for those using light tackle. Successful Brown and Brook Trout anglers use spinners or worms.

Fishing Regulations

The Au Train River at this location is a designated Type 4 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From Chatham, head east on M-94 towards Munising. Follow M-94 for about 4 miles to Au Train Forest Lake Road (H-03) and make a left. Follow H-03 for about 1.5 miles to a two-track on the east side (right) of the road. Follow two track down to the river. Bank access is steep in most areas. Limited access makes this river unique. Access can also be made at the Au Train Falls overlook.
