This lake is stocked regularly with brook, brown, lake and rainbow trout and splake.

Noteworthy

This lake provides a nice hook-and-bobber nearshore fishery for panfish species, as well as a mid-water fishery for trout. Bait can be purchased at Buck's sporting goods store in downtown Ishpeming.

Fishing Regulations

This lake is a Type C lake. Please see the Inland Trout & Salmon Regulations within the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

Take Highway US-41 to Marquette County's town of Ishpeming. At Lakeshore Drive and Highway US-41 (in the vicinity of the traffic light just west of the McDonald's, and at the corner of Jubilee Foods grocery store), turn south onto Lakeshore Drive. Proceed on Lakeshore Drive past the yellow, blinking caution light intersection into the downtown portion of Ishpeming. At the first stop sign, turn south on County Road 581 and proceed for 1.5 miles to the sign denoting the Lake Angeline public boat launch site. Caution - this is a very steep ramp and you will want to use wheel chocks on both back tires if you are launching a boat.
