### ***Fish Species***

Brook Trout; Brown Trout

### ***Species Description***

Wild brook trout to 13 inches and wild brown trout to 22 inches can be found here.

### ***Noteworthy***

Anglers of the Au Sable has done a considerable amount of habitat work in this reach which is funded in part by the DNR Fisheries Division Habitat Improvement Account. Habitat work includes placement of whole trees and log structures as well as brush bundles.

### ***Fishing Regulations***

The North Branch of the Au Sable River at Twin Bridges is a designated Gear Restricted stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing guide.

### ***Directions to Site***

From County Road 612, turn north on Twin Bridges Road and continue just under two miles north to the bridge crossing at the river. Parking is located at the bridge and there are stairs leading down to the water on either side of the bridge.
