Noteworthy

Habitat improvement projects have been done both upstream and downstream of Pollack Bridge by the local Trout Unlimited Chapter and are partially funded by DNR Fisheries Habitat Improvement Account. Habitat includes whole trees, log structures, spawning riffles, brush bundles and log covers.

Fishing Regulations

The Au Sable River at the Pollack Bridge is a designated Type 1 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From M-72 west of Grayling, go north on Au Sable Trail. Continue on Au Sable Trail until it ends in a T with Pollack Bridge Road and turn right (East). Continue to the river crossing where parking is limited along the side of the road.
