Compartment specific changes made during the Compartment Review:

Compartment 006 (Stand Examiner – Richard McDonald)

- Stand 13 – Focus retention pockets around areas with mixed conifer.
- Stands 25, 40 & 69 – Change MO to upland mixed forest.
- Add recreation trail and roads layer to the map when reposted.
- Stand 90 – Focus retention along the trail and protect trail markers.
- Add drumming log spec to all aspen harvests.
- Refine roads layer to reflect what is on the ground.

Compartment 015 (Stand Examiner – Richard McDonald)

- Stands 1 & 8 – Add recreational trail protection specs.
- Add recreation layer to the map.

Compartment 020 (Stand Examiner – Richard McDonald)

- Add recreational trail layer to the map.
- Stand 40 & 46 – Focus retention islands around nature balsam fir.

Compartment 039 (Stand Examiner – Greg Rekowski)

- Stand 43 – Clearcut, replant to red pine.
- Stand 41 Compartment 037 – Clearcut, replant to red pine.
- Stand 28 – Change from crown thinning to group selection.

- Stands 4 & 89 – Change MO to mixed upland deciduous, remove cultivation treatments.
- Stand 117 – Add recreational trail protections specs.
- Add trail layer to the map.

Compartment 053 (Stand Examiner – Greg Rekowski)

- Add recreation layer to the map.
- Stands 2 & 5 – Notify adjacent landowner of harvest plans.
- Refine road inventory in Section 30.

Compartment 054 (Stand Examiner – Greg Rekowski)

- Stands 42, 46, 48 & 34 – Change proposed start date to FY19, and do not allow harvesting operations during elk hunting seasons.
- Stands 1, 2, 3, 5 & 7 – Do not allow harvesting during elk hunting seasons.
