Mark stand to 70 - 90 BA. Focus on improving quality, releasing crop trees, and re-open or create canopy gaps to encourage northern hardwood regeneration. Remove all merchantable spruce/fir. Leave some large future snag trees for wildlife. Leave cedar, hemlock, and pine if present. Leave most birch and black cherry if present while marking unless needed for operability. Favor species diversity while marking.

Leave some large future snag trees for wildlife. Leave cedar, hemlock, and pine if present. Favor species diversity while marking.

Exclude drainage running E/W across the stand at least one full tree length from lowland ground edge. Exclude and/or buffer any dense hemlock areas. See treatment layer for approximate locations. Include small patch of black spruce in the far NW corner to regenerate area.

The sale boundary and Payment Unit boundaries are marked and identified by blue, red and yellow paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against private property are marked with blue paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against state are marked with red paint. Interior Payment Unit boundaries are marked with yellow paint. Retention patches are marked with red paint; no harvesting activities may occur within these areas. The painted boundary line trees are not Included Timber and are to be protected unless marked with orange paint. Yellow painted trees designating an interior Payment Unit boundary are only to be cut when all surrounding Payment Units have been paid.

**2 - Timber Specifications****2.1 - Included Timber****2.1.3 - Cut Tree Marked Unit(s) (12/08)**

Within Payment Unit(s) 1 - 5, all trees are designated for cutting when marked with orange paint above and below stump height, regardless of merchantability. Remove all merchantable spruce/fir. Also, within Payment Units 2, 3, 4, and 5, remove all merchantable aspen.

**2.2 - Utilization****2.2.6 - Roundwood Operation Required (3/21)**

The skidding of whole trees or tree segments with limbs attached is prohibited. All products must be produced as roundwood and forwarded to existing roads or landing areas in final product length. Trees must be harvested with in-woods processor in order to retain existing understory.

**2.2.7 - Uncut Designated Trees (2/04)**

Liquidated damages of \$5.00 per tree will be assessed for every marked tree not cut.

**3 - Payments****3.4 - Damaged Timber****3.4.1 - Damaged Timber (12/24)**

General Condition and Requirement 3.4 Damaged Timber, defines liquidated damages for undesigned live merchantable trees which are cut or injured. In addition, extreme care should be taken to avoid damage to tree seedlings and saplings.

No damage is acceptable to undesigned live merchantable trees. Within the Sale Area, if more than 5 % of trees (> 4.5" DBH) within a specified area of the sale are damaged, liquidated damages will be assessed for all trees damaged. Rates will be in accordance with General Condition and Requirement 3.4 Damaged Timber.

**4 - Transportation****4.1 - Construction****4.1.4 - Timber Removed for Construction (3/23)**

Trees cut or damaged in the process of pre-approved road, landing, or skid trail construction will be decked in an area separate from other Designated Timber and not removed until measured by the Sale Administrator. Payment will be made at contract prices or average prices, if not on the contract.

**4.1.6 - Road Construction (4/24)**

Construction of new roads or improvements of existing roads shall be done in such a way as to minimize the environmental and visual impacts. Merchantable trees shall be cut and utilized unless otherwise directed. Non-merchantable trees shall be severed and laid flat on the ground. Slash shall be scattered, not left in windrows, and kept a minimum of 10 feet back from the road edge. Stumps shall be set upright, not left on edge, and be moved at least 10 feet away from the road edge. Disturbed soil shall be feathered into the woods and not left in berms or windrows.

**4.1.7 - Road Closure (10/11)**

All new roads built into the sale must be blocked to vehicle traffic upon completion of the sale. Some overgrown roads that are reopened shall be considered new roads. In general, this will require constructing a four (4') foot high berm of stumps and logs covered with earth. Contact the Sale Administrator for specific details of design and placement.

**4.2 - Maintenance****4.2.4 - Grading (10/16)**

For completion of the sale, state forest roads must be graded. In general, this will require a road grader or bulldozer to shape up the roads after forest products have been hauled off site. This includes cleaning of drainage areas, grading, crowning and filling with gravel, if necessary. The grading equipment to be used must be approved by the Unit Manager or his/her representative.

**4.4 - Access****4.4.1 - Private property access (3/11)**

Permission for access across private land is the responsibility of the Purchaser. Should the Purchaser desire to cross private land, a copy of the written permission from the private landowner may be required by the DNR.

**5 - Operations****5.1 - Notification****5.1.1 - Pre-sale Conference (10/25)**

A pre-sale conference between the Purchaser and Sale Administrator is required prior to beginning any operations. The Unit Manager or his/her representative must be contacted at least 10 days in advance to schedule the conference.

**5.2 - Conduct of Operations****5.2.1 - Slash****5.2.1.14 - Chipping of Slash (10/08)**

If tops are chipped, they must be skidded to the landing separately from the bole section of the tree. Skidding of tops must be done in such a way as to minimize damage to the residual trees.

**5.2.2 - Hazard Trees/Snags****5.2.2.1 - Den Trees (10/16)**

Obvious hollow and/or den trees shall be protected and left standing unless they are a safety hazard.

**5.2.3 - Operating Restrictions****5.2.3.1 - Operating Restrictions (9/11)**

Within Payment Unit(s) 4 and 5, cutting, skidding, and hauling MAY be limited to frozen winter conditions. This restriction is due to very saturated access into the sale area. If the purchaser works with the private landowner to make access roads passable during all seasons, Payment Units 4 and 5 contain mostly well drained, dry ground. It would still be recommended that operations within these Payment Units occur during dry summer or frozen winter conditions due to some limited areas containing saturated ground.

**5.2.3.3 - Bark Slippage Restriction (3/09)**

Within Payment Unit(s) 1 - 5, unless changed by verbal agreement, cutting and skidding are not permitted during the period of April 15 to July 15. This restriction is because of bark slippage.

#### 5.2.17 - Timber Mats and Interlocking Composite Mats (5/23)

Some roads or skid trails may require extra protection such as that afforded by timber mats, interlocking composite mats, or another approved system. If available, mats may be borrowed from the DNR. A Timber Sale Contract Amendment will be used to document the Purchaser's use of the DNR's mats. Contact the Sale Administrator regarding availability and pick-up. Timber mats are available from various field offices. Composite mats are only available from the Marquette ICC. The Purchaser is responsible for picking up and hauling the mats to and from the site. The composite mats will require DNR staff onsite for installation and removal. Contact the Sale Administrator to schedule at least 30 days before desired install/removal date. All mats must be cleaned prior to drop off. This may include, but is not limited to, power washing and brushing to remove mud and debris. A charge of \$700.00 per timber mat and \$2,000.00 per composite mat will be assessed for all damaged or non-returned mats. Damage for the crane/timber mats is defined as three or more broken cants. Damage for the composite mats is defined as cracked or broken mats.

#### 5.2.22 - Operating Caution

##### 5.2.22.1 - Operating Caution (6/11)

It is recommended, but not required, that within Payment Unit(s) 1, cutting and skidding occur during dry summer or frozen winter conditions. The reason for the recommendation is due to areas of saturated ground.

#### 5.2.32 - Decking/Landing Restoration (9/13)

All decking and landing areas must have the surface area restored to a condition equal to or better than before. This is to ensure the proper regeneration of the stand. Wood debris, chips and "cookies" from trimmings must be removed or scattered away from landing and loading areas and may not be windrowed on the edge.

#### 5.2.38 - No Decking Against Live Trees (2/04)

Cut products may not be decked against unmarked or designated leave trees.

### 5.4 - Soil Protection

#### 5.4.1 - Rutting Restriction, General (7/16)

Operations are to cease immediately if equipment and weather conditions result in rutting of roads and/or skid trails which are 6 inches or greater in depth and 25 feet in length. Note: Trees within 10 feet of ruts exceeding this standard will be considered damaged due to the roots being severed and will be billed in accordance with specification 3.4 Damaged Timber. The Unit Manager or his/her representative may restrict hauling and/or skidding if ruts exceed the specified depth. With the Unit Manager or his/her representative's approval, the Purchaser may return to the area when the risk of rutting has decreased.

#### 5.4.2 - Skid Trails (2/04)

Skid trails up and down slopes should be avoided. If, however, this is unavoidable, these trails will be left in a non-erodible condition using water bars, logs, and slash. Placing of slash on these skid trails while logging is ongoing may alleviate need for any further action. At the direction of the Sale Administrator, seed, fertilizer, and mulch may also be required.

#### 5.4.6 - Wet Area Protection (5/10)

No harvesting operations, including skidding and felling, are to take place within the vernal pond areas or drainages. When harvesting occurs, there should be no disturbance to the vernal pond depression. All equipment, trees and tops should be kept out of this area. Within 100 feet of the pond, equipment should only be used when the soil is in a dry or frozen condition. Care must be taken by the Purchaser to identify and avoid operating in these areas of the timber sale. Note: Some vernal areas were identified and excluded during sale preparation. Others may still exist that were marked around to be avoided.

## 6 - Safety and Fire Prevention

**6.2 - Signing****6.2.1 - Road Posting (10/20)**

The Purchaser is responsible for posting and maintaining caution signs on Cable Lake Road, Wide Waters Road, and some forest access roads prior to beginning operations. The road must be posted at appropriate distances from the active area to warn of logging activity and truck traffic. Signs must be removed when harvest operations are suspended or completed. The Purchaser will provide these signs.

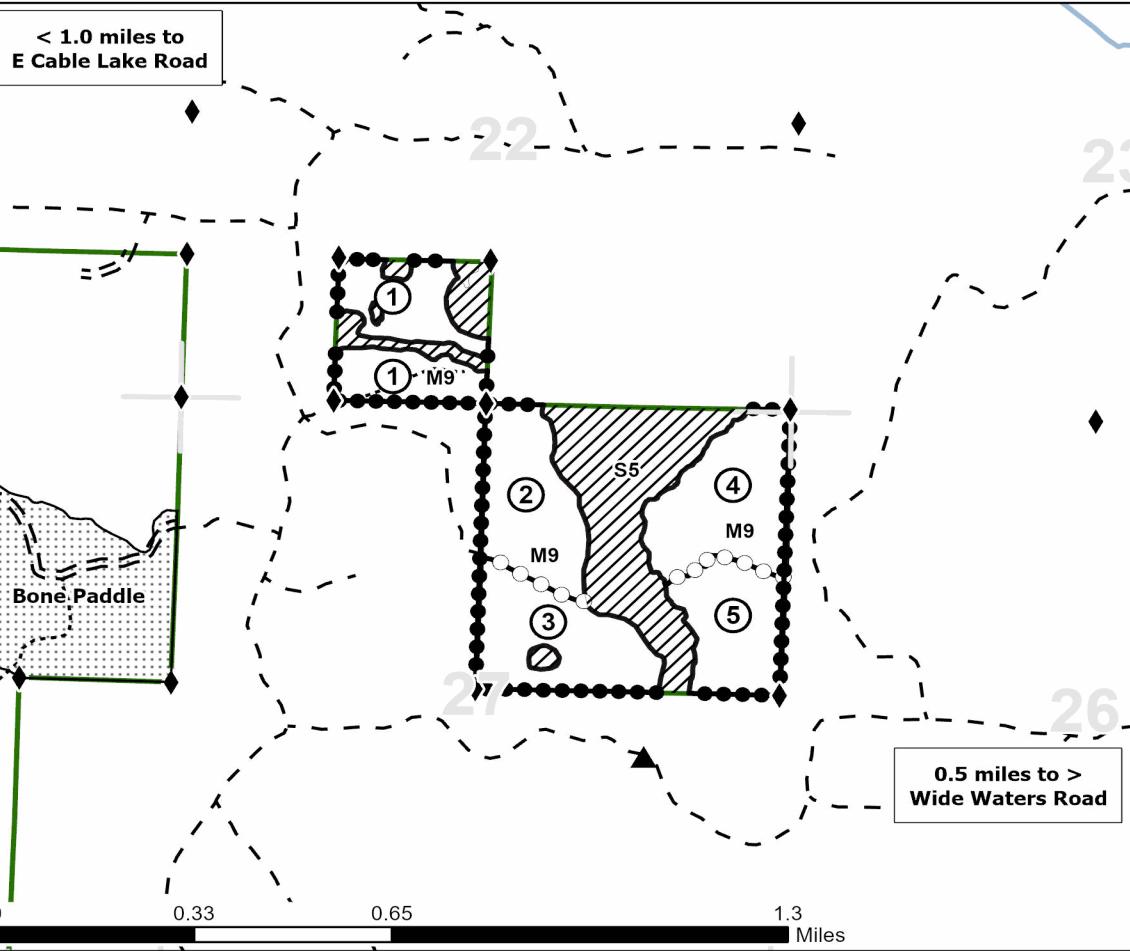
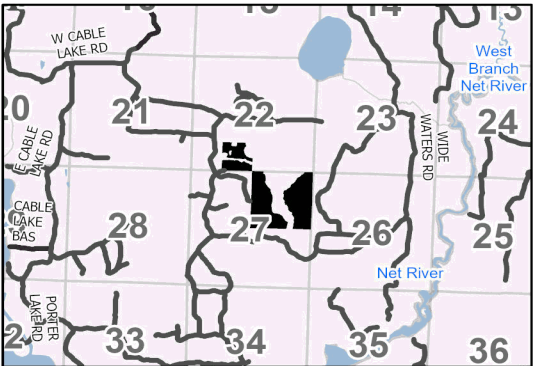
