


## Comments:

Access via Road 64, 65, and Tin Shanty Road. Landings will provide enough room to stage equipment. Terrain is flat to gently rolling. A few scattered large diameter red pine are present throughout. A horse trail follows the closed road south of Road 64. Additional horse trails meander throughout the east part of the treatment, these are marked with yellow pin flags. Small interior retention at east end around a horse trail. DO NOT LEAVE GAPS AROUND EDGES. TRENCH ALL THE WAY TO RED LINE EDGES. Adjacent cover types are immature and will not cause much shading impacts. Leave a 10 foot buffer around the horse trails at the east end.
