

Trench & plant RP at standard spacing. Additional treatments may include roller-chopping and herbicide spraying.

Comments:

Best access will be through private property located just north of the Wildwood Pathway east parking lot. Private landowner intends to put a gate at this location (currently bermed). This access point connects to a haul route on stateland that was used during harvest operations. Terrain is hilly but not steep, more level ground in E/SE. Was an M9 stand prior to harvest, features sandy loam hardwood soils. Cherry and/or aspen whips, 5-10ft, are quickly regenerating in most areas. Seedling density ranges 'medium to well'. Red oak left per Rx, most concentrated in a small area in east. Prescribed by Roell, prep/admin by JSP.
