



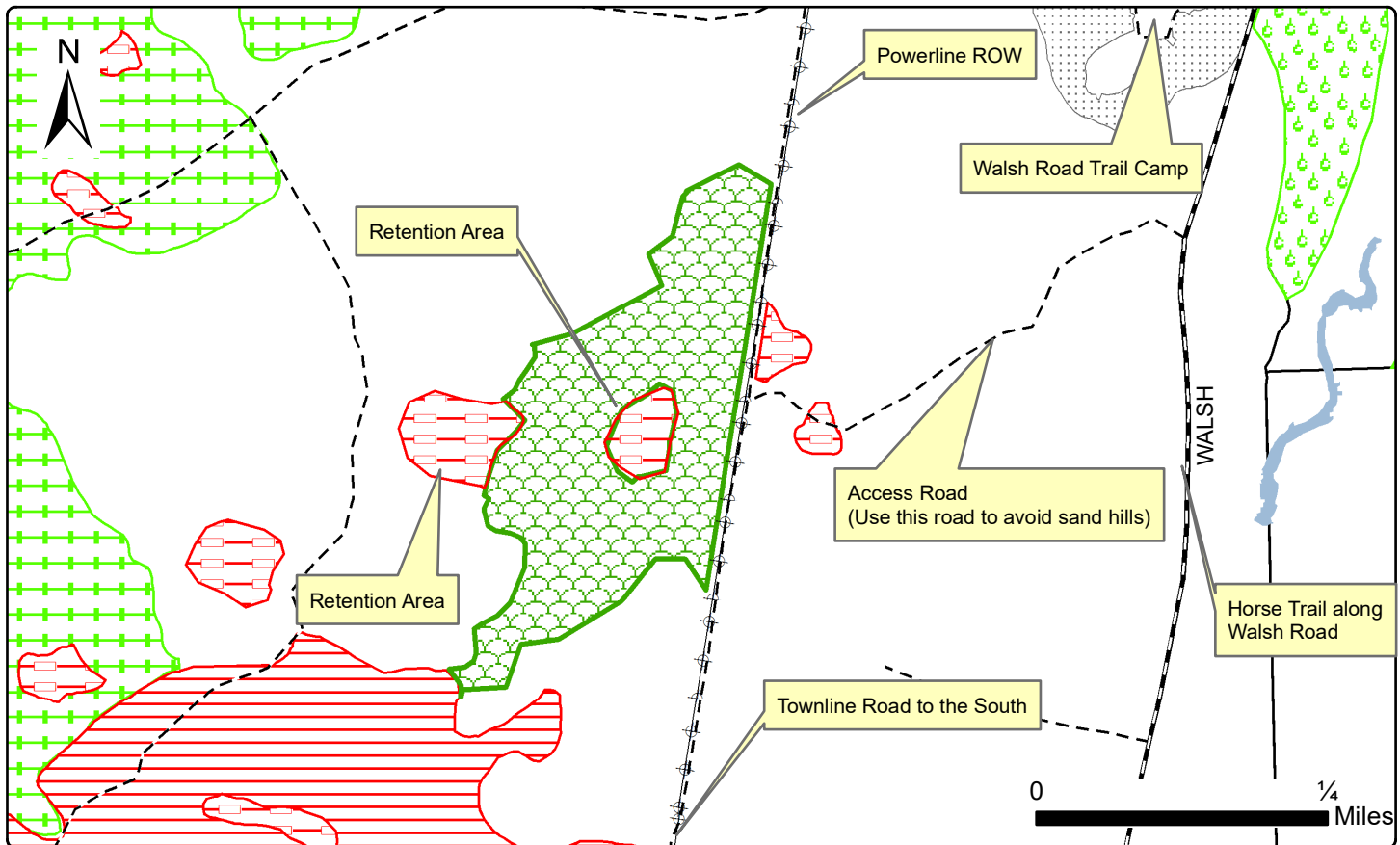

<p>Comments:</p> <p>The treatment area was harvested in summer 2022. Middle Branch Big Creek is to the east and Pickerel Lake is to the north of treatment area. A powerline is adjacent to the eastern treatment boundary. Walsh Road is also a designated Horse Trail directly east of treatment area.</p> <p>Timber sale was whole tree skid, slashed and chipped at the landing. Treatment area has approximately 50% coverage of dense Aspen/Oak/Red maple regeneration less than 2 inches not cut during timber sale. Slash loading is minimal to none.</p> <p>Site is to be roller chopped/fecon, sprayed, trenched, and planted to Red Pine according to TMS Specifications.</p>
