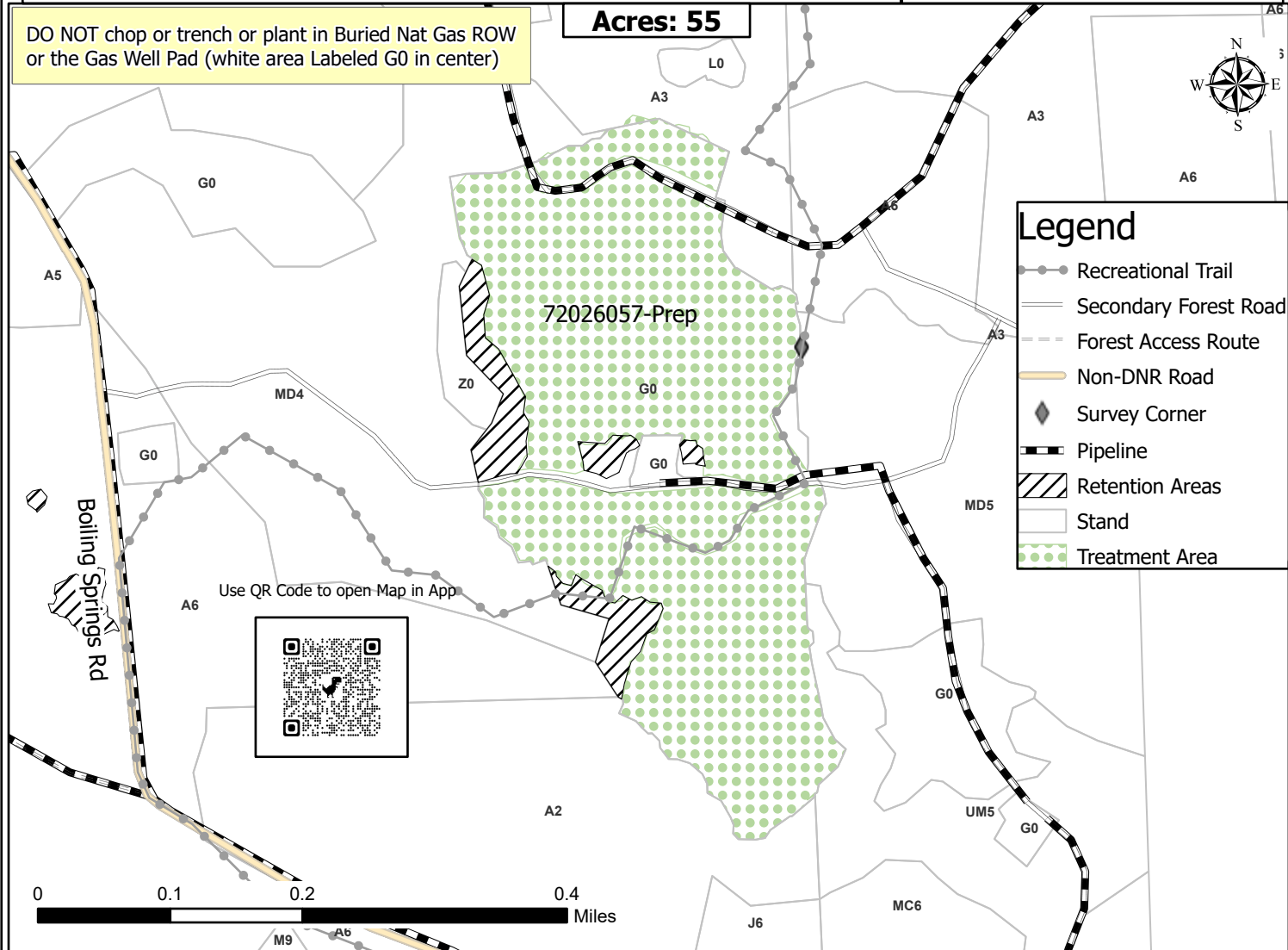
**Implementation Notes**

Comments: Pipelines and electric cables are buried along the County roads and wellsite access roads. These are to be excluded from chopping, and trenching operations. Site may need to be chopped depending on aspen regeneration. Sale was cut in Fall/Winter 23. Stumps are low with the exception of some scattered larger pine. Widely scattered legacy pine present in unit.  
 Note: A motorcycle trail runs across the treatment. Best access is off of Boiling Springs Road on the State Forest Road that splits the treatment.
