Approved Methods:

Burn periodically to restore & maintain the Shupac Prairie ERA. Use existing roads where possible to minimize construction of new fire lines & reduce encroachment of invasive plants. Alternating burns between spring, summer & fall, varying the burn intensity, & varying the fire return interval (ideally, between 1 - 5 years) will benefit the widest range of species.

Additional Instructions & Notes

There are pipelines and gas well sites bordering and within the burn area. Protect the survey corner and its witness trees under the powerline in the the NW of stand 3. The first version of this FTP was approved in 2019. This revised version adds stands 4, 10, & 12 to the Shupac Prairie burn area, as prescribed through the 2020 YOE planning process.
