REC: Snowmobile trail/Jones Lake Rd		Covertypes Obj: Pine Barrens. The objective will be to set back woody succession and promote growth of pine barrens vegetation. Approved Methods: Burn periodically for pine barrens restoration and maintenance. Vary the burn season when conditions allow. Additional Treatments may include non-commercial treatments such as thinning, pruning ladder fuels, brush-hogging, roller-chopping, and other slash management may be done to facilitate burning.
WATER: None w/in 500 ft		
HAL: Sites located west of Jones Lake Rd, not affected by burn.		
MNFI: Dusted skipper and cobweb skipper. Hill's thistle and rough fescue nearby.		

Implementation Notes

Comments: Refer to Camp Grayling Pine Barrens Management Plan for detailed guidance.
Note: Tank trail is located along west portion of burn and is extremely sandy in areas. Numerous roads and trails throughout provide opportunity for smaller burn blocks if desired. Lowlands labeled V0 on map are seasonally wet and equipment should avoid running through these areas. The stands labeled U0 on the northeast side of burn area were harvested in 2023 and contain heavy hardwood slash. Look at forested jack pine stands and assess prep needs for running fire through them.
