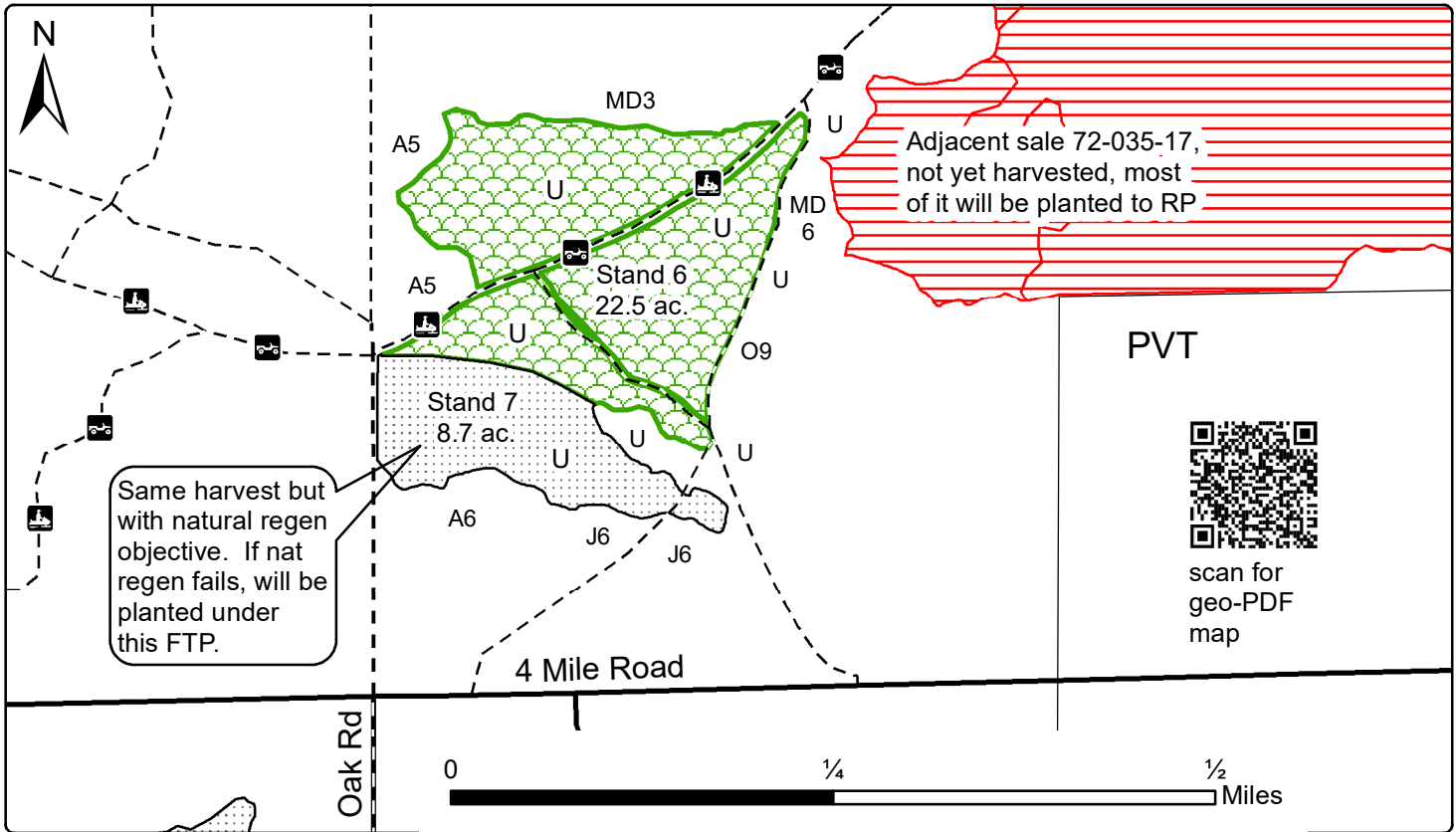

Timber sale was chipped and producer did a pretty good job keeping stumps low with the exception of a few large double stems. Stand 7 was cut at the same time but has a natural regen objective with a back-up plan to plant red pine if the nat regen fails. That nat regen will be checked next year prior to trenching, and the stand's 8.7 acres will be added to this FTP if the nat regen is inadequate. Leave open all of the mapped roads within the planting area.
