

Trench & plant RP at standard spacing. Leave open existing roads within the planting area. Additional treatments may include chopping & skidder herbicide.

Comments: Stand was cut fall of 2020 as part of About Time Red Pine #72-044-19. Sale has not been closed yet because purchaser needs to remove timber mats out of boneyard. Sale expires 3/31/22 and will be closed by then. FTP has been developed early to give fire officers a close location to do site prep work this spring during fire season and to avoid the need for rollerchopping if possible. Stumps were cut low and sale was chipped. Some rolling topography present. Aspen and maple regen came back pretty thick in places following harvest and will require herbicide treatment. Scattered oak residuals present as well. 2.2 acres of stand 17 west of pipeline/horse trail has been excluded from treatment area.
