Additional Instructions & Notes

Leave open all mapped roads. Protect the Cycle Trail that crosses through the south end of stand 4. Don't crowd the ski pathway on the east edge of stand 38. The pipeline that bisects stand 22 can't be crossed with heavy equipment unless it is capped; the crossing timbers used for harvest access were removed. Stands 22 & 38 have tall stumps from past thinnings; some of those stumps are still solid in the center.

Prescription

Approved Methods:

Trench & plant RP, with additional treatments that may include herbicide and pre-commercial thinning.
