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Implementation Notes

Comments: Treatment is accessed North of Townline Road to the West of Walsh Road. Forest roads to the north and east of treatment area are brushed in and not accessible to equipment without additional work. Lowboy will not make it into treatment area and should be left at Townline.

- Sale was not chipped. Slash was laid flat however there are areas of heavy slash loading and larger tops which were required to be broken down. Chopping is required to get good trenches. Be aware there are about 6 to 8 high stumps that were double oak (should be cut above fern height).
