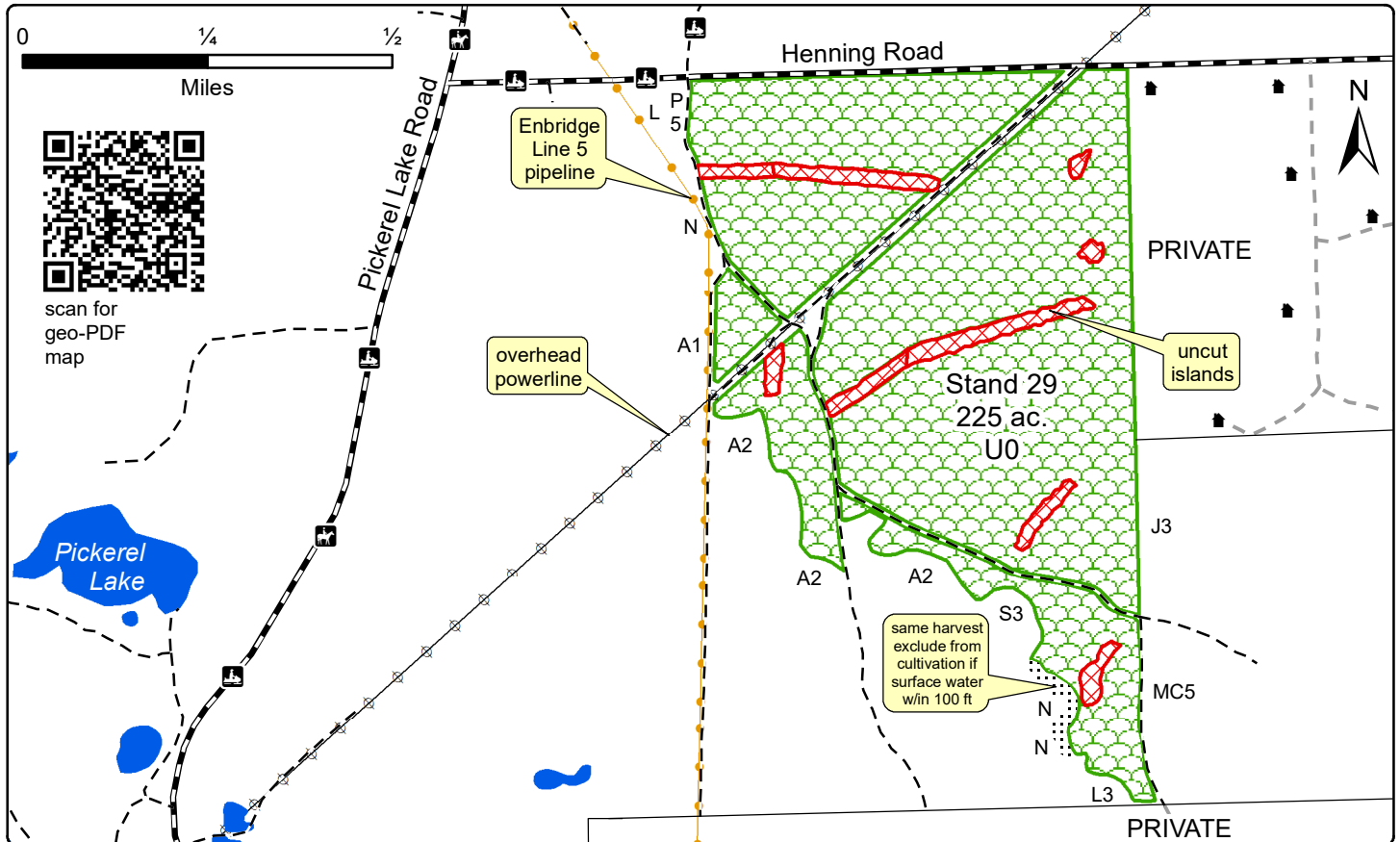

Covertyp Objective: Natural Jack Pine	Acres: 225
Approved Methods: Scarify to promote natural Jack Pine regeneration. Regen goal is at least 800 stems per acre of JP & mixed deciduous. If regen fails the monitoring survey to be done at 3 years post-harvest, trench and interplant JP. Protect open roads & utility corridors.

Contract TCR date: Still open. Waiting for clean-up.	
Comments: The sale was tree-length harvested, with tops and slash scattered for natural regen. Good scarification occurred with snow-off conditions. Scattered legacy Red and White Pine are present. A few large dead Oak were left standing as well. There are a pair of small marsh wetlands bordering the far SW edge of the FTP area. If those marshes have surface water, exclude from cultivation a 100-foot buffer along them.
