



Objective: Planted red pine.

Methods: Trench then plant to red pine. Push trench line all the way to treatment edges.

Location: Otsego County, T32N R01W, Sections 9 and 10

Comments: Clearcut winter of 2024-25, chipped fall of 2025. Most stumps are low but a few high ones may be present. Chipping was done at "bare minimum" levels so there are still areas where slash is present. Terrain is mostly flat. A few scattered leaf trees are present, mostly pine, but some died from ice storm damage.

Recreation: Equestrian trails follow closed roads in the treatment area. The Towermans Watch Hiking Path meanders through the southeast part of the treatment. The Pigeon River State Forest Campground borders the northern edge of the treatment.

Fisheries: The Pigeon River is nearby to the west.

Wildlife/MNFI: Wood turtle and Hill's thistle hits are nearby but not in the treatment area.
