

Access via Ford Lake Road. Landings will provide enough room to stage equipment. Terrain is flat to gently rolling. Residual BA of red pine is roughly 35 square feet. Some areas of heavy slash accumulation due to inadequate chipping. The Shingle Mill Pathway is on the far southern edge of the treatment boundary.
