- 29 A plat and record of a survey of Sec. 2 in Leavitt for  
A. C. Gandy, J. D. Gilbert, and others.
- 30 As the length and amount of each parcel are given in the  
plat I shall describe only the corners on this page.
- 1 A post under which are pieces of a stone water  
churn. A mistake is in the field notes describing this corner,  
Field notes should read Horn. 14 in. diameter bears S 32° E 14 l. (Instead of that  
they say "Horn 14 in. S. bears S 32° W. 14 l." Found old stake all right.)
- 2 A post from which Horn 8 in diam S 78° E 7 links  
Beech 8 " " N 51° W, 24 links.
- 3 A large boulder with a bulge on the S. side resembling an ox  
beak on the S. side.
- 4 A light colored rough boulder with a face 26 inches long on  
and 14 wide facing the south and a roundish side to  
the north.
- 5 A post from which Beech 4 in Diameter N 45° W 2 1/2 links
- 6 A post driven down, but not witnessed,
- 7 A rough boulder with a X on the top, beside of which is a Beech  
stake.
