THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 24 day of June 1929, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-nine (A. D. 1929) between HIRAM J. STEVENS and MAE ETHEL STEVENS, his wife, of Mio, Michigan, parties of the first part, and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the exchange of certain lands as authorized by the Act of Congress approved March 3, 1925, (43 Stat., 1215), the receipt of which consideration is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its successors and assigns forever, the following described parcels or tracts of land situated in Oscoda County, Michigan, to wit:

The entire Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-seven (27);

The Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE NE) of Section Thirty-three (33);

The Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW NW) and the East one-half of the Southwest Quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW) of Section Thirty-four (34), all in Township Twenty-six (26) North of Range Two (2) East, Michigan Meridian, containing 320 acres, more or less.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, as herein described, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part and to

its successors and assigns, FOREVER.

And the said Hiram J. Stevens and Mae Ethel Stevens, his wife, parties of the first part, for themselves, their heirs, administrators and assigns, do covenant, grant, bargain and agree to and with the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, that at the time of the ensembling and delivery of these presents they are well seized of the above granted premises in fee simple; that they are free from all incumbrances whatever, and that they will, and their heirs, administrators and assigns shall WARRANT AND DEFEND the same against all lawful claims whatsoever.
