B. DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND AND/OR METHOD APPLIED IN RESTORING OR REESTABLISHING CORNER:

I found a 5" square concrete monument stamped "T18N R14W, S17, S18, S19, S20, 1964, RLS 13584" in a large cattail swamp. The corner is 252 feet South of the centerline of U.S - 10. There is no occupation at the corner location. The corner fits well with all recovered accessories.

Condition of accessories: #1 Did not locate, #2 Did not locate, #3 - #6 Gone, #7 Found dead, #8 Found dead, #9 Found in good Condition, #10 Found down, #11 Found.

C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING THE POSITION OF THE CORNER:

I accepted the 5" square concrete monument as a substantial marker for the corner and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
