1937 USGLO Dependent Resurvey Guy R. Veal Cadastral Eng.

Mon.- The point for the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23, as determined from bearing trees mkd. in 1912 by C. O. Seeley, County Surveyor, who perpetuated the original cor. which had been reestablished by John Randall, County Surveyor, about 1884, from the original bearing trees.

Set a concrete block, 8 ins. long, 6 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, at intersection of old roads bearing N. and S. and E. and W., for deposit to mark cor.,

Wit: The remains of bearing trees mkd. by Seeley.

A cedar clump, bears N. $61\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 107 lks. (70.62) dist.

A white pine, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 50° W., 161 lks.

At a point S. 60° W., 1.00 ch. (66.00) dist. from the cor.,

Set a concrete monument, 24 ins. long, 6 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, for witness cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23, with brass tablet, $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ ins. diam., 3 in. stem, embedded in top and mkd.
