

RE: Sections 4 & 9, Town 23 North, Range 12 West, Springville Township, Wexford County.

Dear Carol,

A control survey was completed around Sections 4 & 9 and all record Government corners were recovered with the exception of the following.

At the East One-quarter of Section 9 we located the bottom half of a PK nail that fit one record witness (Power Pole West). The remaining witnesses of record had no nails for measurement. Based on the Surveys of record for this section line, it appeared that the corner was to be established midway and on line between section corners. The found broken PK was 2.0 feet south of SP. Reset this corner midway and on line between section corners with a pointed 1/2' by 3" rerod (concrete road under asphalt). Placed nails in record witnesses and measurements checked close.

At the Southwest Corner of Section 9 the Spike of record was located and tied. In addition approximately 4.0 feet to the Southeast a strong dip was located (sounds like fairly large object). The issue of double monuments will need to be resolved.

At the South One-quarter of Section 9 the record RR spike was gone and a PK was set temporally for tie purposes. In the process of establishing this position based on record witnesses we found that one of the record witnesses was recorded wrong (power pole SE, bad distance) the three remaining wits checked good. This corner may also need to be resolved based on two monuments at the Southwest Corner. (Recorded as a lost corner and set midway and on line)

The West One-quarter Corner of Section 9 was set by James Ray PS at a fence corner according to Section 9 was set by James Ray PS at a fence corner according to record. GLO calls for a 20" Yellow pine stub. At approximately 14' East of the Ray Quarter corner the remains of a 20" Yellow pine Stump was located that seems to better fit the GLO corners North and South. At the Ray position no stump remains were found and the fence does not appear to be that old. Not sure if the existing fence was constructed on older fence location, (to much snow). This corner location will need to be resolve.






