The Cadillac Management Unit, Baldwin Field Office, <u>TIMBER SALE</u> Notice for sales being offered at 3:00 p.m., on May 5, 2010, has a second correction to the Sale Specific Conditions & Requirements section, on page 4, for **C15 State Pine**, **63-012-09-01**.

"Mixed oak" has been added to the following specification:

## 2.1.3 - Cut tree marked unit(s)

Within Payment Unit(s), all trees are designated for cutting when marked with orange paint above and below stump height, regardless of merchantability. Also, cut all mixed oak, red maple, aspen, black cherry, and jack pine. In addition, cut all red pine that are 10" DBH and larger. Do not cut white oak that are 10" DBH and larger.

The following specification is also added:

## 5.2.39 - ORV trail/route protection

The Tin Cup Spring motorcycle trail and route is shown on the Timber Sale Map. Do not cut trees or damage posts with orange ORV markers. Maintain a 20 foot wide slash, debris, and rut free zone daily using the ORV trail or route as the centerline. Do not run equipment down the ORV trail. Skidding across the trail or route may only occur in locations approved by the sale administrator.
