REVISION NOTICE #1 - April 23, 2012

SCHEDULED SALE DATE AND TIME: 3:00 p.m. (local time) on Monday, April 30, 2012

LOCATION: GWINN MGMT UNIT, 410 WEST M-35, GWINN, MI 49841

This prospectus has been modified with the following changes.

CARLSHEND HARDWOODS timber sale (32-018-11-01) and SAND RIVER SPLIT SALE timber sale (32-119-11-01) conditions and requirements have been modified. Specification 2.2.9 was deleted and Specifications 2.2.10 and 5.2.32 were added to both sales. The percent damage in Specification 3.4.1 was changed from 5% to 3%.

The original specifications were as follows:

2.2.9 - No chipping permitted (12/08)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1-4, all wood must be removed by tree segment, or roundwood. No chipping is permitted.

3.4.1 - Damaged timber (6/05)

General Condition and Requirement 3.4 Damaged Timber, defines liquidated damages for undesignated live merchantable trees which are cut or injured. In addition, extreme care should be taken to avoid damage to tree seedlings and saplings. Damage to residual trees (defined as breaking of the cambium layer, broken tops or bending of trees from their natural position) is not acceptable.

Within the sale area, if more than 5% of the tree seedlings or saplings (1/4" to 4.5" DBH) within a specified portion of the sale area are damaged, liquidated damages will be assessed at \$100 per acre for all acreage within that specified portion of the sale area that was damaged.

No damage is acceptable to merchantable trees. Within the sale area, if more than 5% of trees (> 4.5" DBH) within a specified area of the sale are damaged, liquidated damages will be assessed for all trees damaged. Rates will be in accordance with General Condition and Requirement 3.4 Damaged Timber, or at a rate of \$50 per sawtimber tree and \$5 per pole sized tree, whichever is greater.

The revised specifications are as follows:

2.2.10 - No chipping tops and limbs (4/12)

Within Payment Unit(s) , chipping of the bole, 2-inches in diameter or greater, is allowed. Chipping of limbs or portions of the tree less than 2-inches in diameter is not permitted. Limbs and the remaining top must be left on site and scattered.

3.4.1 - Damaged timber (6/05)

General Condition and Requirement 3.4 Damaged Timber, defines liquidated damages for undesignated live merchantable trees which are cut or injured. In addition, extreme care should be taken to avoid damage to tree seedlings and saplings. Damage to residual trees (defined as breaking of the cambium layer, broken tops or bending of trees from their natural position) is not acceptable.

Within the sale area, if more than 5% of the tree seedlings or saplings (1/4" to 4.5" DBH) within a specified portion of the sale area are damaged, liquidated damages will be assessed at \$100 per acre for all acreage within that specified portion of the sale area that was damaged.

No damage is acceptable to merchantable trees. Within the sale area, if more than 5% of trees (> 4.5" DBH) within a specified area of the sale are damaged, liquidated damages will be assessed for all trees damaged. Rates will be in accordance with General Condition and Requirement 3.4 Damaged Timber, or at a rate of \$50 per sawtimber tree and \$5 per pole sized tree, whichever is greater.

5.2.32 - Decking/landing restoration (9/11)

All decking and landing areas must have the surface area restored to a condition equal to or better than

before. This is to ensure the proper regeneration of the stand.
