This prospectus has been modified with the following changes.

Lake Effect_MWR timber sale (11-024-17) conditions and requirements have been modified. The yellow painted patch cut areas in Payment Unit 1 do not have orange painted trees. All trees within the yellow boundary are to be harvested. Specification 2.1.3 was written as follows:

2.1.3 - Cut tree marked unit(s) (12/08)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1, all trees are designated for cutting when marked with orange paint above and below stump height, regardless of merchantability. Note: this unit is part of a silviculture research project. Within this unit, in addition to standard marking, there are circular areas that all the trees are marked in orange, with a boundary painted in yellow. The yellow painted boundary trees are to be protected during harvest. As part of the research project, in this unit all wood less then 9" in diameter is to be left on site.

And has been updated to:

2.1.3 - Cut tree marked unit(s) (12/08)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1, all trees are designated for cutting when marked with orange paint above and below stump height, regardless of merchantability. ALSO, within Payment Unit 1, cut all trees that are two (2) inches or more at DBH within designated patch-cut areas (bounded by yellow paint). Yellow painted boundary trees are not to be harvested. The total area of the patch cuts is 1.95 acres, with each patch being 0.15 acres in size. 13 patch cut areas are located within the 30 acre treatment area bounded by red paint. As part of the research project, in this unit all wood less then 9" in diameter is to be left on site.
