#### **Species Description**

Rainbow trout are present in Big Chub Lake. Most fish are in the 10-17 inch size range, but larger fish are occasionally caught.

### Noteworthy

Big Chub Lake is 75 acres in size and 74 feet deep at its deepest point. In addition to rainbow trout anglers can expect to catch a variety of fish including largemouth bass and northern pike.

Big Chub Lake is a designated Type B trout lake. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide. Big Chub Lake is stocked annually with 5,000 yearling rainbow trout.

#### **Directions to Site**

Access site is at the end of Chub Lake Drive off of Old State Road (CR F-38). The undeveloped ramp is at the end of Chub Lake Drive. Parking is limited to pulling off on the shoulder of the road.
