Species Description

Rainbow trout are the predominant species and size range depends on the time of year. Sub-legal fish are abundant soon after stocking in the spring. By late summer, fish stocked in that year are around 11-13 inches. Some fish survive multiple years, and trout in the 15-18 inch range have been reported by anglers.

Noteworthy

Gravel parking lot and gravel boat launch. There is a rustic toilet at the access site. The site is closed from 11 pm to 4 am.

Fishing Regulations

Hemlock Lake is a designated Type B trout lake. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Lake Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide. There is no natural reproduction, so the rainbow trout population is sustained solely by annual stocking. Bluegills, largemouth bass, black crappies, and yellow perch also are present. Follow statewide regulations for all other species of fish.

Directions to Site

There is a boat launch and parking (10 spaces) at the Hemlock Lake DNR access site off Taylor Drive. This site is about 0.1 miles from the Hemlock Lake Road/Taylor Drive intersection.
