Noteworthy

This site is owned and operated seasonally during the non-winter months by Saugatuck Township near the Village of Douglas. The park has a picnic shelter, tennis courts, playground, grills, nature trail and pit toilets. There is a boat launch fee.

Fishing Regulations

Kalamazoo River is not designated a trout stream at this location, however, resident runs of lake trout can be caught in the late fall. Brown trout and rainbow trout/steelhead are stocked in the river to provide anglers with winter and spring opportunities. Please refer to the Regulations for Streams Not Classified as Stream Type or Listed as a Gear Restricted Stream regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the Village of Douglas, follow A-2 south and then east on 130th Avenue/Wiley Road. Shultz Park Drive is on the north side before you cross US Hwy 196. Access at this site has parking for 52 boat trailers and provides two boat launch docks.
